Interview with a Corporate Member







Laude San Pedro International College is a School for pupils aged 3-18 years old, delivering the full British National Curriculum as well as the Spanish Secondary Education (ESO and Bachillerato) to over 50 nationalities represented in School.

The school was established in 2004 and in 2014 it became part of the International Schools Partnership, which is a global group of over 30 schools in Europe, North and Latin America, the Middle East and Southeast Asia. This provides many benefits including developing a professional network of colleagues from around the world, to share best practice with; but most importantly, this network enables Laude San Pedro to offer students a truly global learning experience and an international awareness, which goes beyond what the normal curriculum offers in most international schools.

Today we talk with **Amanda Hughes**, who is the Principal of Laude San Pedro International **College**, having joined the school in September 2018. She has been fortunate to work in both the public and selective system within the UK, as well as two other private international schools in Spain. During her time in one of these posts in Spain Amanda led the Secondary School and Sixth Form through the first British Schools Overseas accreditation in the world, which subsequently led to HMC status.

Why is Laude San Pedro so recognised in Málaga?

At Laude San Pedro we strive to be the international school of choice for the national and expatriate community in Marbella, pursuing academic excellence whilst reflecting the identity of our students in all of our work and school celebrations. You are a British school with a great understanding of student exchanges between both countries, what are the advantages?

The movement of students between the UK and Spain has been ongoing for many years and the fact that 8,820 students from Spain enrolled into UK universities in 2016-2017 shows that there is a strong demand. Many of our students go onto undergraduate studies in the UK and they do extremely well. We are now currently launching an recently learnt that a graduate from Laude San International Buddy Exchange Programme and Pedro has won the Imperial College "Faculty of Natural Sciences Make a Difference Competition" and the Accelerator Prize for his work "developing a compound that could be introduced to filtration systems at wastewater treatment plants to attract and trap microplastics and prevent them from entering the environment."

Our GCSE and A Level results, as well as the Spanish Selectividad, are well above the national averages in both countries and we will continue working in this direction to ensure our students have the best opportunities to enter top level universities worldwide and be successful and progress in their future careers.

For international students who have just relocated, and for Spanish families who choose the British education system as an option, we also offer an extremely successful Accelerated English Programme and Personalised Student Services, so that pupils have the support they need to access the curriculum and make amazing progress.

this will give our students the opportunity to stay with a peer for one month and study in one our global network of sister schools. It is a very exciting development and will create an increasingly interesting web of learning possibilities, as the students share their experiences upon their return to school. We are also building a professional community for our teachers and staff so that they can learn from and share experiences with each other.
